The regular monthly meeting of the Oxford Board of Port Wardens was called to order by the acting chairman, Larry Murray, at 7:00 p.m., in the meeting room of the Oxford Community Services Building.

The only other member in attendance was Nancy Cook.

It was agreed to defer the reading of the minutes of July 1, 2010 until next month's meeting.

The board members had before them drawings that have been submitted by the Public Works Superintendent, Scott Delude, regarding the rehab of the town ferry dock. Mr. Murray noted that this was discussed at the workshop with the Commissioners held the night before on August 4. It was decided at the time by the Commissioners that the Port Wardens would write a letter to Sandy Pepe, with the Waterways Department of the DNR, requesting her to take a look at a floating dock for dinghies for use by transients coming into town. Mr. Murray presented a letter he had prepared for review at this evenings meeting adding that he would get a copy to the Board of Port Wardens Chairman, Tom Campbell, for him to review and comment on as well. Mrs. Cook thought the letter was fine but suggested providing as an attachment a section of the preliminary site plan showing that area in which they would like to see the floating dock. Mr. Murray noted that he would make sure that was done.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
